**Application Deadlines:**

Applications for full-time admission will be accepted until the last working day prior to the start of classes for that given semester. Part-time student applications are accepted up to and including the first week of classes.

**High School Transcripts or GED:**

Clinton Community College requires an official copy of your high school transcript showing all of your coursework completed to date. A final transcript indicating high school graduation is required before a final admission decision can be made. Faxed transcripts are not considered official documents. A GED will be accepted in lieu of a high school transcript. Failure to provide these documents could mean a delay in your final admission to Clinton Community College and/or a delay in the release of financial aid benefits.

**Previous College Transcripts:**

If you have previously attended other colleges, you must have official academic transcripts sent from those institutions. These Registrar's offices often require such a request be made in writing, and there may be a charge for the transcript service. Failure to provide these documents could mean a delay in your final admission to Clinton Community College and/or a delay in the release of financial aid benefits.

**ACT or SAT Test Scores:**
