***SUNY Plattsburgh Child Care Center,***

located in Sibley Hall on Rugar Street, operates a Full-Day Program for children between the ages of **6 weeks to 5 years**, and a Morning Preschool Program for **3 and 4-year-olds**.

The **Full-Day Program** operates with three contract periods Fall, Spring and Summer, Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

The **Morning Preschool Program** operates Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon at the start of the Fall Semester through June.

***Eligibility***

The program enrolls children between six weeks and five years of age.

***Teachers and Program Goals***

Staff at our Center, selected for their education and experience in early childhood, strive to plan meaningful days for children in a nurturing and enriching environment.

Curriculum plans are developed based on key experiences in child development and on the cues and initiatives of the children. Emphasis is placed on supporting each child's development of self-esteem and self-confidence resulting in the child's ability and desire to learn.

The Center's staff seek to help children develop a strong sense of self so that they may become confident, inventive, responsible and productive adults.

***Tuition and Tuition Subsidies***

A weekly tuition is charged for the services offered by the Child Care Center.

Eligible *students* may apply for tuition subsidies through a Child Care and Development Block Grant, if funding is available. ***These subsidies can significantly reduce the weekly fee.***
