How to Show Financial Guarantee

In compliance with United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) regulations, all international applicants must provide evidence of sufficient funds available for their studies. We require:

- a current bank statement (dated within the past six months) on bank letterhead
- bank statement must include the name of the account holder and currency clearly indicated in English

Note: an Affidavit of Support CANNOT be used in place of a bank statement.

If you need assistance translating your documents into English, we recommend using the World Education Services to find a certified translator.

If the family name (surname) of the account holder on the financial statement is different from your own, you will need to provide a letter written in English from that individual stating his or her relationship to you and intention to financially support your education.
