Responsibilities: The successful candidate will provide program coordination and teaching with the combined equivalent of 15 credit hours per semester. Instruct courses central to the discipline with a focus on interviewing, problem-solving, and group skills. Additional duties include conducting scheduled office hours for student conferences, academic advisement, participation on college committees, as assigned, and continuing professional growth. Demonstrate willingness and ability to teach remotely and be trained on Brightspace prior to the opening of the Fall 2024 semester.

Qualifications: Master's degree in Human Services, Counseling, Social Work, or closely related discipline is required. Certification in Credentialed Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Counseling (CASAC) and two years experience teaching at the college level is preferred. Applicants who do not meet the minimum qualifications as stated are encouraged to put in writing precisely how their background and experience have prepared them for the responsibilities of the position and by providing appropriate references. Exceptions to the degree requirements may be made for compelling reasons.
