Federal regulations now require proof of non-filing only if the person files a **NON-IRS** tax return (e.g, foreign country, Puerto Rico, etc.) if they were to file. This is required even for zero income.

Independent students, their spouses, and dependent student’s parents who did not file taxes must submit proof that they did not file a tax return.

If, according to the taxing authority regulations, the student/spouse and/or parent(s) **were required** to file a federal tax return but failed to do so, all financial aid processing will be delayed until the return is filed, processed by the IRS and appropriate documentation is submitted to the Financial Aid Office.
